CENTERVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S Crime Scene Investigation (CSI) Camp

CSI camp is available to those who have just completed 6th, 7th or 8th grade in Centerville local schools. Our one-day camp offers your son or daughter the opportunity to meet and work with actual Crime Scene Investigators from the Centerville Police Department and experience the world of crime scene investigation. This unique program is ideal for those interested in law enforcement and/or forensics.

The morning begins with classroom instruction on lifting fingerprints, recovering simulated blood, taking crime scene photos, and diagramming a crime scene (proper behavior is expected). After lunch, *provided at no expense*, it's the

camper's turn to become the crime scene investigator. A scene will be set and everyone will get the opportunity to lift prints, recover simulated blood, take photographs, and draw the crime scene (no one will be exposed to any hazards). Each child in attendance will receive a **Crime Scene Camp** shirt.

CSI camp is limited to 35 students. Your child can only attend one session. **REGISTRATION IS FREE** and will be on a first come, first serve basis
