- **III. Treasurer's Report (Stephanie Wierwille)** We remitted the balance for the fun run to the school. The report includes a detailed winterfest breakdown and Kroger revenue. We also donated to a family that had a health situation.

IV. Principal's Report (Amy Allen)

A. PVS Service Night is Feb 27th from 6-7:30. We will have stations set up around the building to support different charities. We've made blankets in the past, animal toys, close 10 or more stations. You go to each station, make something and it goes to the charity. There will be a snack in the cooking classroom.

V. Committee Reports

A. Square One Art (Suzanne Mitolo) –Fundraiser for the school. The kids do artwork and the company puts it on 50 different products ranging in price. We do this every other year. Timing this to be ready for mother's day. Previous years, we did this during the winter holidays. The school made close to \$2,000 last time we did this project. She will need a few parent volunteers when the orders arrive-the beginning of May (May 6th) to organize the products to distribute to the classroom. Ms. Mitolo asked if we would prefer to have her organize a specific project or have the kids make their own art. The PTO members present suggested that the kids make their own art.

B. Winterfest Summary (Laura McAlpine/Katie Johnson) We felt that it went fantastic. The vision for next year is to utilize the gym. Use the divider and have the silent auction be up front and the frosty shop in the back so parents can browse the silent auction while the kids are in the frosty shop. We are going to track admissions too. Goal is to have registration be more seamless. Offer pizza by the slice (at a cost from 11-1pm).

Kristi had 11 total sponsors for \$3,100 dollars. Last year we had \$3,400, 5 returning sponsors, 6 new sponsors. First time sponsor-Sit Means Sit was a great hit. Aqua-tots donated the bags again. Brusters car wash donated \$400 worth of \$17 dollar car wash cards to put in the bags. 171 individual businesses donated and we divided them into 133 lots. 30 of those were teacher baskets. Total value of the teacher baskets was a little over \$5000. Business donations \$12,542. Estimated total silent auction earnings-\$6,943.

C. Book Fair (Rachel Casey)

Jungle theme. February 21st-27th. On the 20th we will be setting up. Will create a sign up for shifts. 27th-will need help tearing down after service night. New this year is the e-wallet. Parents can set it up-put money on, so kids do not need to carry cash or check. A refund will be issued about 5 days later for any amounts not used. The book fair funds the scholastic news and scholastic dollars that helps pay for the publications. We try to buy per neighborhood. The school currently has \$5,008.24 in Scholastic dollars.
