




Insight: Learning embedded in authentic experiences focuses on children's natural environments and provides opportunities for them to construct their own understandings.

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



Our Belief

The staff at Primary Village South (PVS) believes children are full of potential and are capable of developing their own theories about the world around them when given opportunities and time. The following represents a PVS core belief: "The quality of education changes when time is valued. Children are not rushed from one activity to the next, but have time to be enveloped by an experience. When teachers are intentional about listening to the children's conversations and ideas, and facilitating meaningful encounters, wonderful investigations begin. They become invested in learning and take ownership of their projects because their ideas are respected and valued, and...they know there will always be enough time".

Insight: Learning builds children's interests and needs in an atmosphere that encourages risk-taking, promotes reflection, and honors time for individual development.



Literacy: Primary Village South promotes and supports balanced literacy instruction that provides opportunities for authentic reading, listening, speaking and writing. Literacy instruction is embedded throughout our young learners' day focused on student developmental levels and individual instructional needs. Reading specialists and intervention teachers are also available to support individual students' learning.



Insight: Rich learning occurs when children inquire and engage in mindful learning experiences leading to thoughtful processing and active problem-solving.



OUR LEARNING

Authentic Learning Experiences:

Each day offers a learning opportunity full of wonder and inquiry. Primary Village South supports child-centered learning where the classroom learning environment is constructed jointly between the classroom teacher and the students. Documentation of student processing and thinking fill our walls and classrooms.



Math: Children learn best when math is taught through hands-on experiences that develop critical thinking, mathematical reasoning and creative problem solving. The Every Day Math program is a spiraling curriculum that uses manipulatives and math games to engage students. Through the use

of special projects, students have the opportunity to use math in an authentic and differentiated way.

Insight: Children who are mindfully engaged and have a voice in their learning become empowered, self-motivated and on the path to life-long learning.



Our Community



PVS was founded on “Nine Insights” centered on our belief in the inherent abilities of young learners. This belief

is shared by our many community and family volunteers, who play a key role in the success of our school.



Insight: The collaborative school community values and promotes meaningful interaction and communication among students, teachers, parents, and community members.




Our Special Places



The Café: Early literacy experiences are strengthened by spending time with children in conversation. Lunch at Primary Village South is a time for first graders to engage in meaningful conversations. Parent volunteers and staff members assist in the café to help students practice good manners and encourage purposeful conversations.



Integrated Arts: The arts are integrated throughout our young learners day. All students are involved in art, music, library and physical education through a rotating schedule. Additional enrichments are determined from year-to-year.



The Outdoor Classroom: The grounds outside PVS provide a natural environment that support students' curiosity and create a sense of wonder. Outdoor places include our own woods and areas created by the children such as the Butterfly Garden, Meadow, Maze and ABC Kinder-Garden.



Young Five's Program: To better meet the varying needs of kindergarten students, we offer a Young Five's Program. The program is designed for those children who are five by September 30th, but who will benefit socially, emotionally, and physically by having an additional year of growth in our K-1 program.

Insight: It is critical to embrace all aspects of a child's development (social, emotional, cognitive, and physical) and nurture growth over time through high expectations anchored in open-ended experiences.
